Mechanical permits are needed for residents to hook-up to natural gas lines becoming available in Tyrone Twp.

On your permit application you will need (line 1) for inspection

Show the number of openings (line 10)

Gas piping system shall be sized based on BTU's of appliances and total distance from meter.

Appliance orifices need to be changed for each appliance being serviced for natural gas changeover.

If piping or any connections are concealed or buried- a gas pressure testing will need to be witnessed. All shall be tested.

Some vendors require a pressure gauge installed and approved gas pressure test in order to hookup new appliances.

If you are going to use brand new appliances (furnace, dryer, water heater, etc), you will need to indicate that on your permit as well.

You can pull a permit as a homeowner but need to have it inspected and approved. If you have any further questions call the Mechanical Inspector (phone # on permit application).
